

Service Opportunities:

- **February 1st** – help set up and serve mac n’ cheese at the First Reconciliation Celebration at St. Paul of the Cross. 11:30am -1:00pm
- **February 16th & March 22nd** – Coffee hour at St. Paul of the Cross after 9:45am Mass, help serve and clean up, or drop off baked goods
- **February 17th & March 16th** – packaging materials for parishioners to take home for Dress-a-Girl at St. Paul of the Cross 7:00pm (6pm on March 16)
- **February 20th** - Decorate and pack bags for Bethany House women, St. Paul of the Cross, 7pm: Ongoing collection of small toiletry items (lotion, tissues, chapstick, etc.) at each church.
- **February 22nd** – Soup Supper at St. Paul of the Cross, 5:30pm, bring a salad, bread or dessert, help clean up at the end
- **February 26th** – Ash Wednesday service at St. Agnes; greet families as they arrive OR be a reader (3 readers needed: 1st reading, 2nd reading, and prayers of the faithful)
- **March 1st** - Care packages for Young Adults away from home – bake cookies; purchase hot cocoa, popcorn, candy; make cards, bookmarks, or small items to package for college students, those in the military, or away from home – drop off to Parish Office or Brendan Hall
- **March** – *these can be done at home!* writing Easter cards to families (generic) for the Food Pantry baskets. No limit!
- **Children/Family Stations of the Cross** – Fridays of Lent: 2/28, 3/6, 3/13, 3/20, 3/27, 4/3 Stations are held at St. Paul of the Cross at 4:00pm, St. Rose at 7:00pm, and St. Agnes at 7:30pm – you can attend any of these and we will be glad to have you participate by leading a station or walking with the cross as others pray
- **Children’s Liturgy of the Word**, help in the back of the church with young children. Any Sunday, ongoing. You can do once a month or once in awhile! Whatever works for you.
- **Cleaning** churches, decorating for Easter (contact me for dates and info)
